### A2 Card Measurements:

**Cardstock:** Island Indigo cardstock base 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"  
Misc. patterned DSP mat 5 1/4" x 4"  
Whisper White circle appx 3 1/2"  
Island Indigo scalloped circle appx 3 3/4"  
Scraps of Pear Pizzazz and Island Indigo

**Stamps:** Hero Arts Layering Peacock

**Ink:** Island Indigo, Pear Pizzazz, Versamark

**Accessories:** Assorted pearls and rhinestones  
Assorted mini flower dies/punches

### Instructions to make this card:

1. Fold the sheet of Island Indigo cardstock in half to form the base of the card
2. Adhere the patterned sheet of DSP onto the Island Indigo card base
3. Die cut a circle (appx 3 1/2") from Whisper White cardstock
4. Die cut a scalloped circle (appx 3 3/4") from Island Indigo cardstock
5. Using Island Indigo ink, stamp the sentiment in the upper right corner of the white die cut circle
6. Adhere the white die cut circle onto the Island Indigo scalloped circle
7. Using pop dots, adhere the circles to the center of the card front
8. On the piece of scrap white cardstock, stamp the peacock's body in Island Indigo ink (stamping off once prior to stamping)
9. Stamp the layering peacock's body again in Island Indigo ink (without stamping off)
10. Stamp the 1<sup>st</sup> layer of the peacock's tail in Pear Pizzazz, the second layer in Island Indigo and heat emboss the third layer of the peacock's tail using Gold embossing powder
11. Die cut the entire peacock out and adhere using pop dots to the left of the circle.
12. Attach rhinestones to the peacock's tail
13. Using a mini flower punch or small flower die, cut flowers in both Island Indigo and Pear Pizzazz
14. Layer the flowers onto the circle using pop dots.
15. Place pearls in the center of some of the mini flowers.
16. Stamp the inside of the card and envelope as desired.
